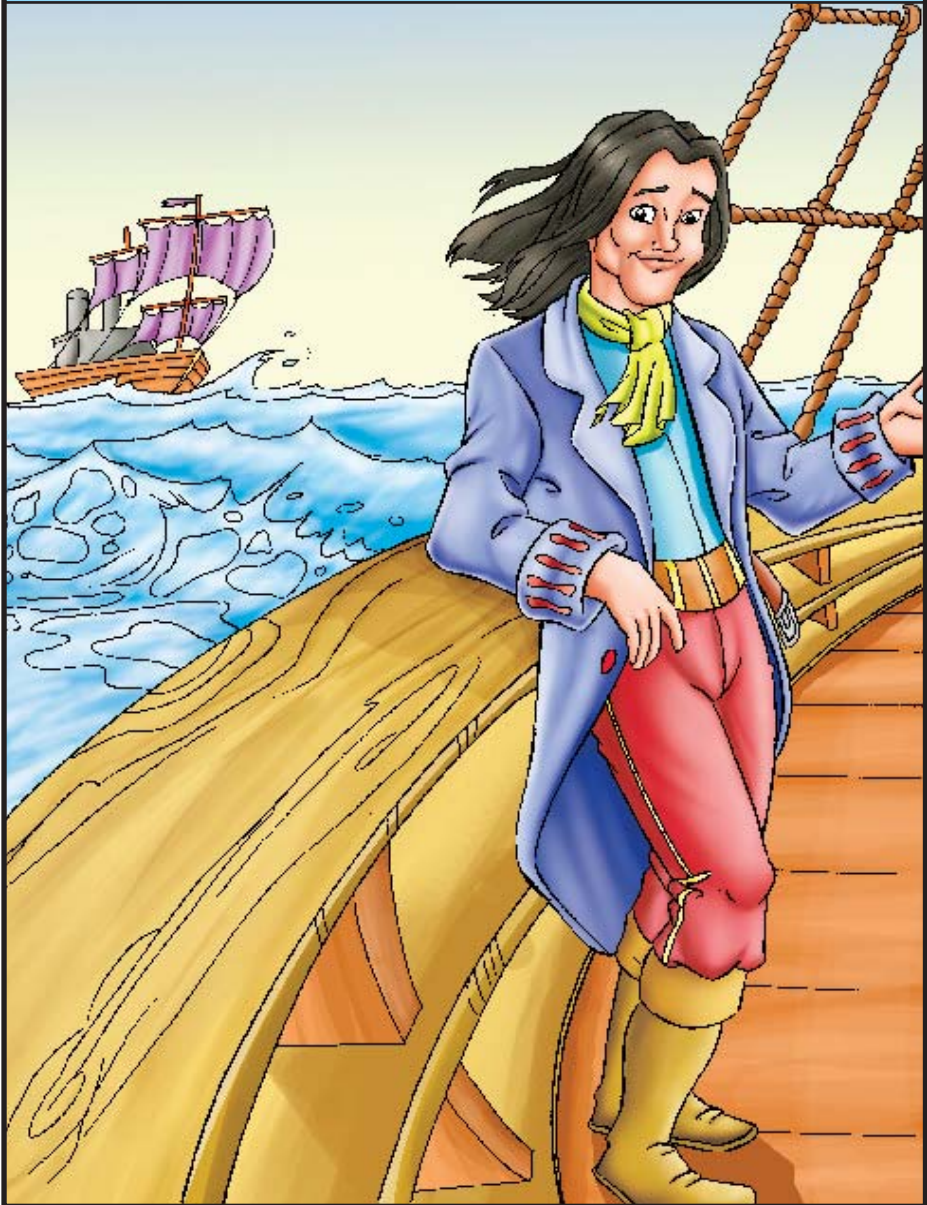


PART-1
VOYAGE TO LILLIPUT

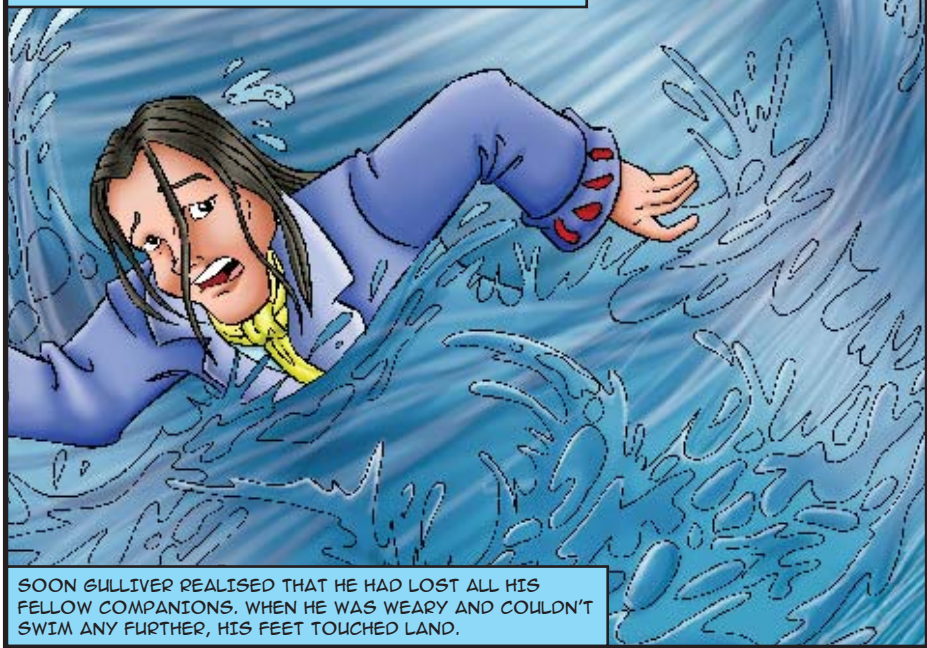

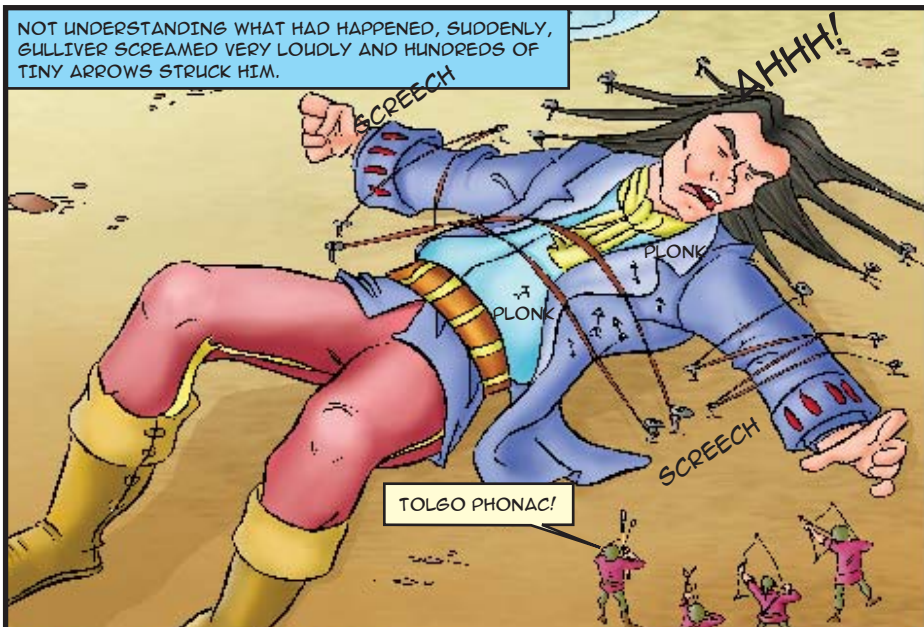
